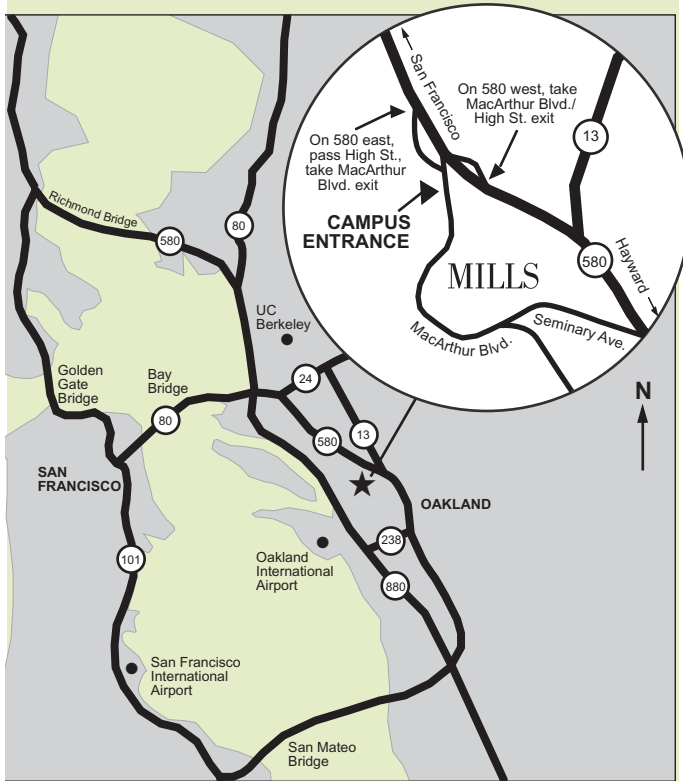


DIRECTIONS TO MILLS



From Highway 80 or 880:

1. Take 580 going east for about 7 miles.
2. After passing the 35th Avenue and High Street exits, take the next* MacArthur Blvd. exit.
3. The exit will curve to the right, ending at a stop sign.
4. Directly ahead is a stop light which marks the campus entrance on the left.

From the Warren Freeway or San Leandro and points east:

1. Take 580 west
2. Take the MacArthur Blvd./High Street* exit immediately after the Seminary Avenue exit and the Highway 13 interchange.
3. At the exit's stop sign, turn left under the freeway, and immediately left again at the first stop light.
4. The next stop light, which marks the campus entrance on the left will be immediately ahead.

*There are **three** different MacArthur Blvd. exits from Highway 580, so it is important to look for the exit sequences noted above.
